

Wenge Penguin

Majestic lines and inviting contours

Hans Bunde created Penguin in 1954, one for each of his daughters. The original idea was to create Penguin in ebony wood. With wenge wood we got as close to his original thought as possible.

Wenge penguin is crafted in wenge wood and silky smooth beech wood. The fine lines that appear naturally in wenge wood will get less noticeable over time and will uphold its majestic appearance. It is available in 3 sizes - Mini, Small and Large.

Depending on how you arrange the Penguins - and whether they appear as single or as a flock - they elegantly symbolize family ties, friendship and love.

Hans Bunde was a highly skilled silversmith, and graduated from the internationally renowned Cohr Silver. Bundes artistic nature ordered him to play with other materials, besides his work with silver. He designed objects in his spare time that are recognizable through its simple and elegant aesthetics.
