The name "Pausefisk" carries a special place in Danish history. During the era of flow TV, the term referred to a familiar onscreen pause - a brief moment of respite between programs on Danish television. Pausefisk honors that heritage by offering you a chance to disconnect from screens and embrace a quiet moment of introspection.
